This fall the Lexington Church of Christ is hosting the First Annual Boston--World Missions Seminar on October 8-10. We are tremendously excited to be able to host this great event as we have customarily held the New England Evangelism Seminar on the Columbus Day weekend. We want to broaden the scope of the seminar so as to complement the work that we have begun with the Boston School of World Missions.

This seminar, like the New England Evangelism Seminar, is designed to instruct, train, and motivate Christians to speak and live God's message in their daily lives as well as how to build up local congregations. It will also be informative as to the progress of how the world is being reached for Christ. Many of the speakers will be missionaries and pioneers in world evangelism.

The theme speakers for this event will be Chuck Lucas, Doug Arthur, Jerry Jones, Doug Blough, Stanley Shipp, and Kip McKean, as well as others still to be contacted. We are also very excited to announce that the evening sessions of the seminar will be held at our new facility in Boston, which we recently purchased. (The present seating capacity of this old Baptist church building, built in 1869, is around 1500. We hope to complete the necessary restorations by September and expand the auditorium to close to 2000.) The daytime schedule for the seminar will be held at the Sheraton Boston Hotel.
